Dear Property Owner or Resident,

As part of the Casaloma Drive Urbanization project, there will be periodic closures of North Casaloma Drive north of Capitol Drive. The first of these closures is scheduled for July 2nd to the 3rd, between Amberwood Lane and Prairie Song Lane.

A temporary access road has been constructed between Rose Meadow Lane and Cobble Creek Drive in order to preserve access to your property. A map depicting the temporary access road and how to get to it are on the back of this letter. We suggest using this route throughout the construction north of Capitol Drive.

Although the contractor is committed to limiting the number and duration of road closures, these closures are necessary to complete the utility and street work in a safe and timely manner. Updated project and road closure information will be available through the Grand Chute web site at www.grandchute.net under the news link on the left side of the home page and on the Department of Public Works page.
