Gillett Street between Capitol Drive and Greenlawn Lane will be closed to through traffic but will remain open to local traffic. There will also be periodic road closures throughout the project. We advise avoiding the work area as much as possible.

Mail is being delivered to the temporary mailbox bank on West Starview Drive for the North Gillett Street properties north of I-41. Once you pick up your mail, please turn around in the cul-de-sac rather than private driveways. Mail is being delivered to the temporary mailbox bank on West Hiawatha Drive for the properties south of I-41.

## Looking Ahead: Schedule for Week of Jul 30- Aug 3

PTS Contractors is scheduled to continue installing storm sewer and appurtenances between Capitol Drive and the Gillett Street retention pond. They are also scheduled to complete the retention pond connection and the Elsner Road storm sewer stub. Once the north section work is completed, they will move both crews to the south end of the project to continue storm sewer main installation between Capitol Drive and the Gillett Street retention pond.

RC Excavating is scheduled to begin street excavation north of the Gillett Street retention pond once PTS Contractors completes the storm sewer installation north of the Gillett Street retention pond.

### Future Schedule:

RC Excavating is scheduled to continue street excavation north of the Gillett Street retention pond.

PTS Contractors is scheduled to install storm sewer between Capitol Drive and the Gillett Street retention pond.
