Project Update

Week of Oct. 15-19

Advance Construction made some minor field adjustments to storm structures and sanitary manholes.

Relyco placed base aggregate in the road from Capitol Drive to 300' South of Capitol.

Sommers Construction constructed concrete liners in the West and South basins for the Bentwood Basin project.

Highway Landscaping framed and poured the Northwest headwall over an existing 72" culvert between Capitol and Victory on the East side of Casaloma Drive.

MCC placed the lower layer of asphalt for the North half of the roundabout at Victory Lane as well as the lower layer of asphalt from Prairie Song to the North.

Looking Ahead: Schedule for Week of Oct. 22-26

Advance Construction is tentatively planning on placing storm laterals across Amberwood Lane.

Relyco is tentatively planning on placing base aggregate for the asphalt path between Capitol Drive and Victory Lane.

Sommers Construction is tentatively planning to construct concrete driveways between Capitol Drive and Victory Lane, the Bentwood Estates detention basins ditch liners, and the curb and gutter between Victory and Capitol is scheduled to be placed weather permitting.

Future Schedule:

Relyco is scheduled to continue excavating and placing aggregate base course.

Once a sufficient amount of roadway is graded and graveled, Sommers Construction will place curb and gutter. After appropriate concrete curing time, Relyco will backfill the curb and sidewalk.

MCC will fine grade and place asphalt binder course.

Victory Lane roundabout construction work will continue.

NOTES TO RESIDENTS

Casaloma Drive will be closed to through traffic but will remain open to local traffic. We advise avoiding the work area as much as possible.

The temporary access road from Cobble Creek Drive is open.
