RC Excavating excavated the road at Capitol Drive and placed aggregate base course at the Capitol Drive intersection. RC Excavating also excavated the road between Hiawatha and Evergreen under Highway 41 and placed aggregate base course.

Looking Ahead: Schedule for Week of Oct 15-19

RC Excavating is scheduled to complete street excavation and placing aggregate base course from Hiawatha to Evergreen. RC will place aggregate base course for sidewalk and asphalt path. RC will adjust manholes throughout project.

Jim Fischer is scheduled to place curb & gutter between Capitol Drive and Evergreen Drive.

Northeast Asphalt is scheduled to pave the asphalt trail between highway 41 and Elsner.

Future Schedule:

Jim Fischer will continue driveway and sidewalk construction south of Evergreen Drive. They will also construct sidewalk and driveways.

RC Excavating will backfill curb and sidewalk areas.

Northeast Asphalt will pave trail and street.

There will be periodic road closures throughout the project. We advise avoiding the work area as much as possible.
