Week of July 6 - 10

The Jacobsen Road reconstruction has progressed to the Kimberly Clark truck entrance, including excavation and aggregate placement for the recreation trail. Bodart Electric installed the new traffic signals and street lighting at the Cold Spring Road and Jacobsen Road intersection. The concrete driveway apron, recreation trail and curb and gutter through the Fire Station 40 driveway off Cold Spring Road has been completed and the remaining concrete recreation trail along Cold Spring Road has been poured. The lawn restoration along the south side of Jacobsen Road has begun in the areas where the curb and gutter has been poured.

Looking Ahead: Schedule for Week of July 13 - 17

Beginning Monday, July 13th, Jacobsen Road between McMahon Drive (west) and the Kimberly Clark truck entrance will be closed. The Kimberly Clark truck entrance access will only be permitted from Cold Spring Road. Starting Wednesday, July 15th through Thursday, July 16th, access to Jacobsen Road from CTH CB will not be permitted. Traffic will need to follow the designated detour route and access Jacobsen Road from Cold Spring Road, including access to the McMahon Business Park will only be from McMahon Drive (east) off Jacobsen Road from Cold Spring Road. Exiting to Jacobsen Road to CTH CB will be permitted July 13th through July 16th. Beginning Friday, July 17th, access to Jacobsen Road from CTH CB will be allowed, however, exiting to Jacobsen Road to CTH CB will not be permitted. Access from CTH CB to Jacobsen Road and from Jacobsen Road to CTH CB will be reinstated at the end of the day Friday, July 17th.



NOTES TO PUBLIC

Jacobsen Road, east of Cold Spring Road remains closed to through traffic. All access to the McMahon Business Park, Kimberly Clark truck entrance and Department of Corrections to be from Cold Spring Road. Businesses located within the McMahon Business Park should enter using McMahon Drive (east) off Jacobsen Road from Cold Spring Road until further updates.
