Week of Jan 30 - Feb 3

PTS Contractors spent the first two days of the week mobilizing, staging, and unloading materials for the water main extension project. The crew started water main installation Wednesday and continued through Thursday evening. The crew was able to install approximately 800 LF of water main from the north end of the project heading south. All traffic control is set up and the southbound lane will continue to be closed weekly, Monday through Thursday. Two-lane traffic will re-open Thursday evenings and carry through the weekend. The southbound shoulder will remain closed within the construction zone.

Looking Ahead to Next Week:

The crew will continue to install water main to the south heading towards the Bodwewadmi Ktegan Farm. Hydrants will be installed in conjunction with the main line as the contractor passes their locations. Site grading and stabilization will continue behind the water main installation crew.

Future Schedule:

Water main installation will continue south throughout the project. A cross tie-in will be installed at the intersection of Kuffner Road and CTH H in the next few weeks. Traffic control will migrate with the crew as they move south. Site grading and stabilization will continue to take place behind the water main installation crew.



The traffic control is set up and traffic patterns along CTH H have been altered for the project. Travel with caution and slowdown when passing through the construction zones. Contact the McMahon on-site representative or PTS Contractors with any concerns or special needs within the project area. Please be mindful of all workers in the construction zones.
