### Week of February 20

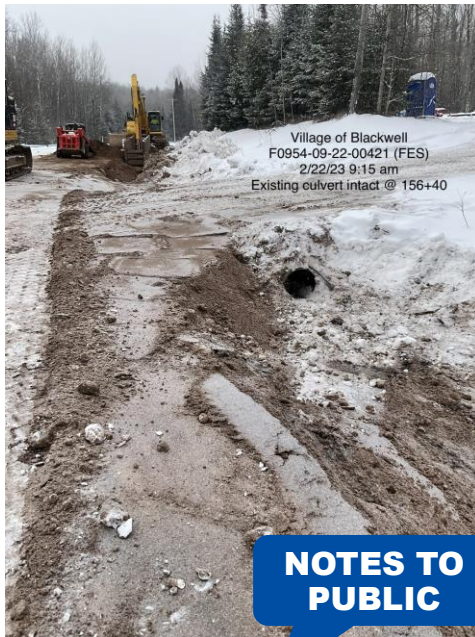
PTS Contractors continued this week with the installation of 8-inch water main south bound down CTH H towards the corner. The crew installed approximately 1400 L.F. of water main and 2 hydrants along the west side of CTH H. The south-bound lane will continue to be closed weekly Monday through Thursday while the crew is working. The crew worked Monday through Wednesday; the week was cut short due to the weather conditions throughout the area. The crew will continue installing water main on Monday February 27th.

### Looking Ahead to Next Week:

The crew will continue to install water main in a southerly direction throughout the project area. Hydrants will be installed in conjunction with the main line as the contractor passes their locations. Site grading and temporary stabilization will continue behind the water main installation crew.

### Future Schedule:

Water main installation will continue south and west throughout the project. Traffic control will migrate with the crew as they move south. PTS Contractors will be adding an additional crew in the next few weeks to start work on the water service laterals. Site grading and stabilization will continue to take place behind the water main installation crew.



**NOTES TO PUBLIC**

The traffic control is set up and traffic patterns along CTH H are changing daily within the project limits. The lane closure will soon be set up around the corner on CTH H making it difficult to see oncoming traffic. Please use extra caution while traveling in these areas.
