# Project Update

## Town of Neenah - Larsen Rd (Clayton Ave - CTH CB) Road Reconstruction



### Week of May 26 - 30

This week, MCC continued working on excavating out marsh material under the existing roadway East of the Rocket Way and Larsen Road intersection and replaced this with new suitable material to improve the base for the new road. The whole road width is being replaced during this phase of construction which may cause some delays for residents. Residents may have to take a different route compared to what they are used to but will still have access to their properties.

### Next Week (weather dependent):

MCC will continue removing marsh material under the existing roadway, working West to the East. The whole road will be shut down during this phase of construction, but residents will be able to get in and out of their property.



#### NOTES TO PUBLIC

- Larsen Road is closed to thru traffic from Rocket Way to CTH CB. This means that if you don't live between Rocket way and CTH CB or are traveling to a destination located within these same limits, you will need to use an alternate route. Access from CTH CB to Oak Ridge Road will be maintained.
- Larsen Road from Clayton Avenue to Rocket Way will remain open until June 9<sup>th</sup>. At that time, Larsen Road will be closed to thru traffic from Clayton Avenue to CTH CB for the duration of the project.
- There are no marked detour routes for this project.
- The Contractor has updated the tentative schedule, and it is posted on the webpage under "Project Information". The contractor will be updating this schedule as-needed throughout construction.
