Looking Ahead: Description and Upcoming Schedule of Work

During the 2026 construction season, the Village of Belgium will be reconstructing the following streets: **Park Street (Dean Rd to West Ln); West Lane, East Lane, and Antoine Drive.** The reconstruction will include the replacement of all public underground utility mains and service laterals, including watermain, storm sewer, and sanitary sewer (Park St. sanitary main not being replaced-installed in 2017). New storm laterals will be installed to right-of-way. Private sanitary lateral replacement (from right-of-way to home) will also occur for most homes. Following the utility work, all streets will be reconstructed with new road base, asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, and concrete driveway approaches. Park Street width will be narrowed from its existing variable width, the existing roadway widths for the other streets will remain the same. West Lane pavement between Antoine Drive and Park Street will be realigned to better fit within the existing right-of-way.

Utility reconstruction is scheduled to begin the week of July 6, 2026. Once the project begins, roads will be open to local traffic only. Weekly updates will be posted online to inform of progress and status of various construction phases. The project is expected to be completed by mid-October, 2026.
